Intro

Deco Glaze is the water-based glaze that gives brilliant translucency and clarity of colour in a high gloss finish. Its advanced formula, rich in pure acrylic resin, combines the extended working time of oil-based glazes and the ease of water-based technology. **Deco Glaze** achieves gentle loft and manageability in dragging, combing, stippling or any of the application techniques. The low odour formula has a gentle fragrance and dries to a hard surface, which is easily maintained with excellent performance in high traffic interior/exterior areas. **Deco Glaze** can also be reduced with up to 20% water to create a 'watercolour' effect.

Preparation and Application

Engineered with an extended open time of approximately 20-30 minutes, many creative effects are possible with **Deco Glaze**; including ragging, dragging, stippling or a brush application to create a watercolour effect. The techniques work best over smooth, non-porous acrylic surfaces.

Prepare surface in accordance with standard painting practices. Then apply by brush or roller two base coats of **Covered in Paint Satin or Low Sheen**. Allow six hours for drying. On to this surface, the coloured, translucent glaze is applied. Basecoat and **Deco Glaze** colours should complement for best results. To achieve a desired depth of colour when using as a watercolour, two coats may be required. **Deco Glaze** is touch dry in 2 hours. Allow overnight drying if a second coat of Deco glaze is being applied. Clean up in water.

Warning, do not shake contents to avoid aeration. To mix, slowly stir with a paddle.

Suitability

Deco Glaze is suitable for commercial or residential interior walls and woodwork.

Coverage

Spread rate is 8-10m² per litre, per coat. This may vary due to surface porosity, profile and wastage rates.

Colours

Deco Glaze is available in a range of colours.

Packaging

Deco Glaze is available in 500ml, 1litre and 4litre tins.
